Collected funds will go to Rose Shaw Elementary, for their use in assisting school children. We have collected \$307 so far - the total will be announced next week.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

CLEM STRUVE introduced our speaker, **CORPUS CHRISTI MAYOR JOE ADAME**. Mayor Adame noted that no two days are alike, and he is challenged by the uncountable meetings, public appearances, and inevitable appointment

conflicts. At a recent City Council retreat, city leaders formulated realigned goals and the Council is united on bayfront initiatives. Goals include Destination Bayfront, a utility master plan, revised recycling plan (new larger bins), economic development package for downtown and the island; street repairs; development process improvement (better response time); Mary Rhodes Pipeline (to assure future water availability); Mayor's Fitness Council; and supporting a continued military presence in the area. He also noted the role of the TAMUCC International Relations Office and the Coastal Bend Business Innovation Center in working with various cultures and entrepreneurs to promote the Port and City and encourage start-up companies locally. He is impressed with efforts by the Chief of Police to address gang problems. Bold Future has produced some solid plans for the area.
